Education should aim at the training of emotions, because what we bring with us into the world is not a character, but the raw material of character. Our natural inheritance of human desire, impulse and emotions. Aristotle taught human nature that is neither good nor bad. What it becomes will depend upon the ends to which impulse, desire and emotion are directed. Thus a naturally hot temper can be trained to righteous indignation at cruelty and injustice or to be a defiance of all authority. Right living is living in accordance with a rule, a rule which reason prescribes. Aristotle, it may be remembered, points out that the young cannot be expected to

perceive this rule for themselves, since in morals as in art, the preception of what good comes only as a result of practice and experience. Therefore, a boy must be trained to perform right acts by the exercise of authority and through the influences of tradition, before he can realize why they are right.
